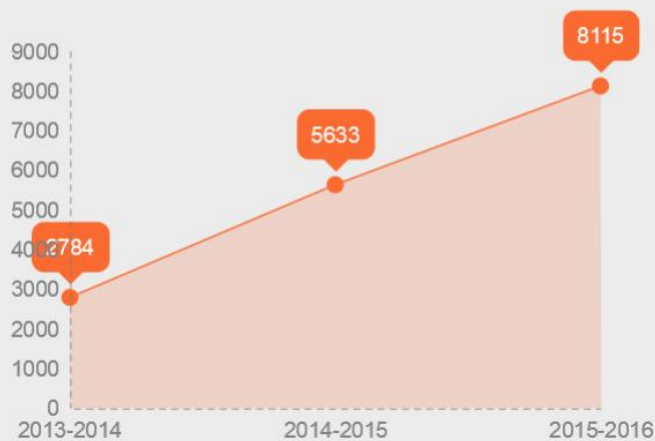

\*Montana public school enrollment has hovered around 144,000.

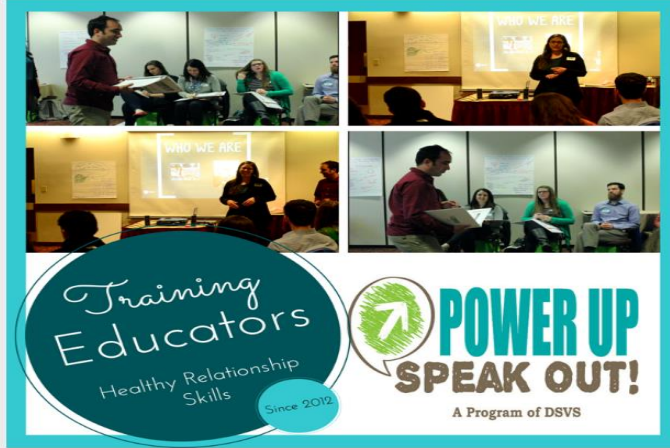


Travis, our lead educator, all dressed up to teach Red Lodge middle school students about healthy relationships.

Attended a Power Up, Speak Out! training in 2015-2016.



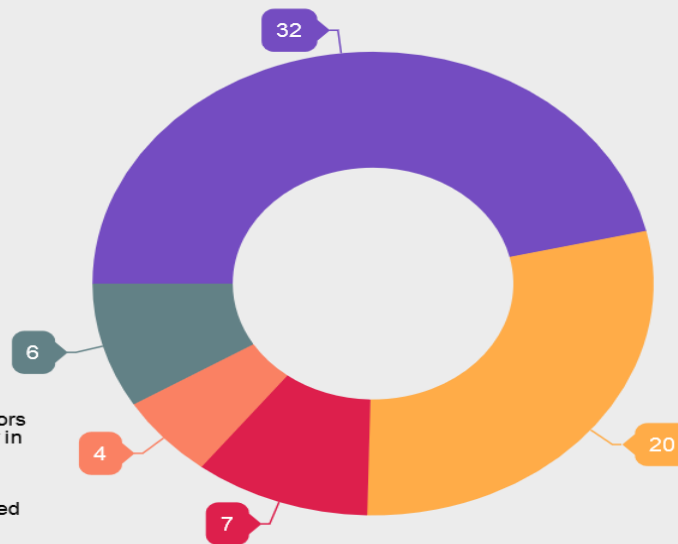
Trainings were held in Billings, Bozeman, Glendive, Helena, and Wolf Point.
